Thank your for responding to the corrective action letter sent to you by DLA dated January 8, 2015. By providing a resolution to discrepancies on your company's quality processes observed during an audit of your company on June 27, 2014, Penn Engineering (cc 56C13) is in compliance with all of DLA's QSLM criteria and provisions on Class 2 and Class 3 Threaded Fasteners.

Also, the QSL office has approved your company's renewal applications as a qualified manufacturer of Class 2 and Class 3 Threaded Fasteners under the QSLM program for another 3 years effective **February 8, 2015**.

As a reminder, your company status as an approve source (for 3 years) will expire on **February 8, 2018**. A renewal application has to be submitted at least 120 days before the expiration date in order for your application be process in a timely manner. If your status expired and no renewal application has been submitted, your company will be removed from the QSL program.
